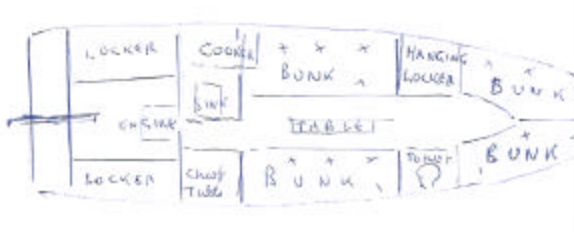


LYANA Seaking 24 Sail no 42, SSR14489

Lying ashore at Walton-on-Naze



Length 25 ft (with rudder) LWL 22 ft, Beam 9ft, draft 3'3" Tons 6.5

Construction: Clinker, Mahogany on oak hull, copper fastenings.

Profile: Curved bow, transom stern, long keel.

History: Purchased 1985/86 at Aldeburgh and brought back to Essex. After 2 years in boatyard, where decks were stripped, replaced with new and sheathed. All steel work removed and re-galvanised. New standing rigging. Re-wired. Hull stripped to bare wood and repainted to International Paints specification. Stuart Turner replaced '88 with 13Hp Sole diesel with all components. Running time approx 50 hrs. Professionally serviced each season.

Sails: Main, jib, Genoa, Storm Jib. All in good order, 2 of each plus spinnaker pole.

Covers: Sail cover, cockpit and winter cover, spray dodgers.

Navigation: Husson VHD. Seafix DHF, Compass, Sextant, Wasp trailing log Auto-helm, charts and other books.

Blake toilet, sink with pump, crockery, pots, pans and cutlery. Two burner stove and grill, gas bottle, small cabin heater and bottle.

Lifebelt with holder and light, fenders, warps, 2 anchors, fuel and water containers, fist aid kit, radar reflector, Binoculars (cheap), flares, safety harness, flotex carpets.

Lights: 3 cabin lights plus chart table (red) side-lights, masthead with wind indicator, 2 batteries.

Bunks: New ones made, never slept on. Inner and outer zip covers.

Boat has basically everything needed except Decca which is no longer operational. Boat has been yard maintained.

The boat is valued by the yard at £8,000, but would like to offer at £6,500 or there about.
