Dauntless 20ft Gunter Cutter serial no 1305



Built at the Dauntless Yard on Canvey Island in 1953, Naiadne is of a well-known design of the region bred for the shallow waters of the Thames Estuary, drawing 18", or four feet when the iron centerboard is lowered. Ideal for mooring on muddy tidal waters, with twin bilge keels , a long keel and lead ballast.

Hull Dauntless number 1305, clinker construction is in good condition for age and has been regularly maintained.

Rudder in timber and iron. Original tiller

Centreboard iron in mahogany case. Rope-hauled with pulleys.

Engine Diesel Yanmar 1GM 10 :(GM10 14824) is newer than the boat and replaces the original petrol engine. A reliable easy-to-maintain, highly regarded type of engine in good condition.

Sails A Gaff-rigged mainsail and two headsails, one on the bowsprit. Easily sailed by one or two people. Roller-reefing on the mainsail and Wickham-Martin roller reefing on the jib. Generously canvassed for her size. The sails are in good repair and the jib has been little used. All rigging, sheets and halyards, jamming cleats, spare chandlery.

Deck is in timber with GRP sheathing and non-slip coating. Navigation lights

Mooring lines, fenders, anchor and anchor chain . Anchor winch, if required.

Cabin with two berths (one mattress). Modern electric lighting. Wet storage area, galley/chart area, chemical toilet in forepeak, shelving . Original timber interior.
