

Dauntless 20 RUTH for sale 1946 build no 1036

This is one of the first three Dauntless 20' yachts built. Her hull is spruce planks on oak frames, which is probably why she still survives. She has had extensive work over the years including re-sheathing the decks, new centre case hog and replacement diesel engine. All this featured within the Dauntless Association newsletter with a host of other photographs available in the archives.



Her current owner Alan Holland is the treasurer of the Dauntless Association and she is reluctantly being sold as family commitments mean that she is not being afforded the sailing and maintenance time she will need. She is in generally sound condition, afloat and in commission during the 2009 season.

RUTH is probably one of the prettiest Dauntlesses built and handles excellently under sail by one person. The new owner must be to try and keep her in the good condition she deserves. They will, of course, have the full support of our Association. A good home and enthusiastic owner is paramount.
